### Blast Off!: Serve One Another

#### **FUN TIME: Kindness Charades (All ages)**

For this activity, you'll need a stopwatch. You will also need a piece of paper to keep score.

The object of the game is to challenge each child to think of one random act of kindness they can do to serve a friend or family member (like doing the dishes, picking up toys, helping a friend with homework, or giving food to someone who's hungry). When they've thought of one, have them act it out in a game of charades while the rest of the family tries to guess what it is.

They will 30 seconds to "act out" what they thought of without speaking. The rest of the group must try to guess what the word is before time runs out. If the group gets it right, the child acting will get the point. The child with the most points wins the game.

**BIBLE TIME:** Those were some great ways we can serve others. Today, we're finishing up our study on taking our faith in God to a higher level. We need to grow spiritually. We've already talked about three of the four habits we need to have and develop in order to grow spiritually. Who remembers what they are? *(Allow for responses - spending time with God, spending time with others and sharing our story of faith.*

Let's look at a Bible story that gives us a great example of our last habit, serving others.

Use the Bible verses and questions below to discuss this with your children. *For toddlers and preschoolers, simply share the answers to these questions with them as you read the Bible story. Keep it short and sweet for them 😊.*

1. Read John 13-17. Discuss how dirty the disciples feet may have been and why.
2. Why do you think Jesus decided to wash His disciples' feet?
3. Why is it important to serve others?

**REAL TIME:** Read Galatians 5:13 (NLT). What can you do this week to serve someone else? How does serving others help you grow in your relationship with God? Let's pray and ask God to show us what we can do and who we can serve .

**PRAYER TIME:** *"Heavenly Father, thank you for giving us Jesus as our example. Show us how we can serve someone and who we should serve this week. In Jesus' Name, Amen!"*
