## God's Love Lasts Forever!

### **FUN TIME: "L is For Love" (Toddlers - Preschoolers)**

You will need 2 sets of large letters to spell L-O-V-E. You can write or print one letter per sheet of paper.

Hide the letters around the house, or area where you'll play the game.

Explain to your children that God's love is the greatest love on earth! Spell the word "LOVE" using one set of the letters. You can do this on the floor. Spell the word out loud for your child and ask them to spell it with you. Tell them to look for these hidden letters around the house. Once all the letters are found, use them to spell "LOVE" as long as their attention holds.

Great job! God's love is the biggest & the greatest because God loves us no matter what. His love lasts forever. It never runs out!

**BIBLE TIME (For All Ages):** Familiarize yourself with the Bible Story of the Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11-32) or read it from a children's story Bible.

After sharing the Bible story, say, "Jesus taught us that God's love for us is like this father's love in our Bible story. God's love lasts forever and He loves us no matter what. Even when we do things that deserve a punishment, God loves us anyway.

We must remember to go to Him when we need help and when we've messed up. If we ask Him to forgive us, and we mean it, He always will. God's love lasts forever!

**REAL TIME:** Ask your three-year-old and preschoolers if they need to ask God to forgive them for doing something wrong. If they do, see if they can explain what it is? Encourage them that God loves them and will forgive them and so do you.

**PRAYER TIME:** *Heavenly Father, thank You for Your love that lasts forever. We ask for Your forgiveness and are thankful that You love us no matter what. In Jesus' Name, Amen!*
