# Day 1 ~ Monday, November 1, 2021

Depart the United States flying overnight to Israel.

# Day 2 ~ Tuesday, November 2, 2021

# Tel Aviv / Tiberias

Arrive Ben Gurion Airport in **Tel Aviv**, directly on the **Mediterranean Sea** and **Israel's largest city**. Meet, assist and begin the journey traveling up the Israeli coastline to **Caesarea**, the Roman capital of Israel. View the beautiful restored **Roman Theater**, **the ruins of the ancient town**, **harbor and aqueduct** before continuing to **Tiberias**.

# Day 3 ~ Wednesday, November 3, 2021

#### **Tiberias**

Join together this morning for a **special service** on the waters of **the Sea of Galilee**. Continue to the **Mount of Beatitudes**, the site of the **Sermon on the Mount**. Onto **Capernaum**, residence of Jesus during his ministry in the Galilee and the location of several of his miracles. See the ruins of the **ancient synagogue**. Next, visit **Magdala**, home of Mary Magdalene and the location of a newly excavated first century synagogue, currently the oldest in the Galilee and one of only seven from that period in all of Israel. Stop to view the **ancient boat** at **Nof Ginnosar**. Proceed to **Tabgha**, the traditional site of the **miracle of loaves and fishes**. Conclude the day with a **Baptism** in the **Jordan River**, at the beautiful site of **Yardenit**. This evening enjoy a **Galilean style grill dinner** on the shores of the Sea of Galilee.

# Day 4 ~ Thursday, November 4, 2021

#### **Tiberias**

Morning tour of the Golan Heights, seeing the former Syrian fortifications, and understanding the strategic importance of this area. View the road to Damascus, driving past Mount Hermon to Mt. Bental, an excellent lookout point towards Syria in the east, the Hermon slopes in the north and northern Golan Heights. Continue to Caesarea Philippi where Peter first confessed Jesus as Christ. The afternoon, drive by Mt. Precipice to Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus.

#### Day 5 ~ Friday, November 5, 2021

#### Tiberias / Jerusalem

This morning, visit **IDF soldiers** patrolling and keeping Israel safe on her northern border. Next, visit **Safed**, one of the **Four Holy Cities** according to tradition and known for its mystical atmosphere and Kabbalistic studies. This town was a center of 16<sup>th</sup> century mysticism and is still a magnet for spiritual "searchers". Absorb the special ambience of contrasts, where ancient synagogues and modern art galleries exist side by side. Explore the narrow, winding alleys. Visit some of the **beautiful synagogues** and browse through the **artists' workshops and galleries** found in the flourishing artist quarter. Next, drive up to **Jerusalem**, enjoying a **welcome service** reciting a **special "Shehechiyanu**" atop **Mount Scopus** upon arrival. As the sun sets, proceed to the **Western Wall (Kotel)** for the traditional bringing in of the **Sabbath**. This evening, special ritual **Shabbat dinner with Rabbi** at the hotel.

#### Day 6 ~ Saturday, November 6, 2021

# Jerusalem

Begin the day with a view of the beautiful panorama from atop the Mount of Olives. Walk Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane for a special service. Proceed to Mount Zion visiting the Upper Room of the Last Supper and King David's Tomb, onto St. Peter in Gallicantu Church overlooking the Kidron Valley and Caiaphas' House. Just as the sun has set, participate in the traditional Havdallah service marking the end of the Sabbath, and the ushering in of the new week. This evening attend the Sound & Light Show at the Tower of David.

# Day 7 ~ Sunday, November 7, 2021

## Jerusalem

The morning begins in the Jewish Quarter of the Old City that was reconstructed after the city was unified at the conclusion of the Six-Day War in 1967. A special point of interest in the restored Jewish Quarter is the "Cardo", meaning the "heart" of this ancient Byzantine City. Visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Walk the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa, through the Ecce Homo Archway for a special service at St. Anne's Church. Next, visit the Davidson Center with its archeological park, one of the largest, most significant archaeological sites in Israel. Experience Ir David, the City of David, with an exciting journey

both above and below ground through **excavations**, **fortresses and passageways**, through the **Canaanite tunnel** to complete the day. This evening, walk through the **Western Wall Tunnel**, experiencing 2,000 years of history.

## Day 8 ~ Monday, November 8, 2021

Jerusalem

Today's full day leads into the **Judean wilderness** for a visit to **Masada**, the mountain top ruin of Herod's Palace and the last fortress of the Jewish revolt against Rome. Onto **Qumran**, overlooking the caves where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** were discovered, followed by a **swim in the Dead Sea**. Return to Jerusalem.

# Day 9 ~ Tuesday, November 9, 2021

Bethlehem / Jerusalem

Morning visit to **Bethlehem**, including the **Church of the Nativity**, **Manger Square** and **Shepherds Field**. Next is a unique opportunity to **meet with new immigrants from Ethiopia** at **YVEL**, and learn of the talented Jewelry institute, teaching them this beautiful trade and art form as a career. Afternoon visit to the **Shrine of the Book at the Israel Museum**, where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** are housed. Included is the **Model of Ancient Jerusalem**, a miniature of the city during the building of the Second Temple. This evening, **Farewell Dinner**.

# Day 10 ~ Wednesday, November 10, 2021

Jerusalem / Enroute

This morning, view Israel's Parliament Knesset grounds with its giant Menorah, followed by a visit to the unforgettable Memorial to the Holocaust at Yad Vashem. Continue to the Friends of Zion Museum dedicated to the outstanding contributions and support, by Christians, to the State of Israel. Conclude the last day in Jerusalem with communion at the Garden Tomb. Evening transfer to the airport with assistance in departure for flight to the United States.
