- **Greeting/Opening Prayer/Food &Friendship**
- **Icebreaker** ~ Reveal something about yourself people may not know about you.
- Testimonies/Good news/What are you thankfulfor?

## **THE NAMES OF GOD -** Book by Marilyn Hickey **JEHOVAH**

This lesson will learn another aspect of Father God: JEHOVAH (YHWH four Hebrew consonants), the Revealing One. JEHOVAH reveals Himself as your intimate, personal God. He walks with you and will never leave nor forsake you. JEHOVAH is the One Who is now and always has been; the God of eternity. The more you grow in this relationship with Him, the more of Himself He will reveal to you.

READ: Exodus 3:4-7 NLT, Exodus 3:14-15 NLT - God revealed Himself as Yahweh (JEHOVAH) to Moses in the wilderness; saying I AM WHO I AM.

1. Tell about the earliest time or age you remember interacting with JEHOVAH (i.e. prayer, talking to and/or hearing God talk to you).

**READ: Exodus 4:1-9 NLT, Exodus 4:10-16 NLT** - JEHOVAH wants an intimate, personal relationship with you as HE had with Moses. His will is that we put all confidence in His Word.

- 2. What was JEHOVAH trying to reveal to Moses in the wilderness?
- 3. What has JEHOVAH been trying to reveal to you?

READ: Exodus 33:19-23 NLT, Psalms 139:1-5 NLT - JEHOVAH can give you fresh inspiration.

- 4. As Moses grew in his relationship with JEHOVAH, Moses asked to see God's glory. What was JEHOVAH's response?
- 5. In what areas of your life could you use fresh inspiration, wisdom, or revelation?
  - **Time of Decision** (Everyone Bow Your Heads)
- 1) Receive Jesus as your Lord and Savior: \*Some may have never received Jesus. \*You may be a good person, giveto the poor, and serve in the community. \*Has there been a day where you confessed Jesus and Lord? (Read Romans 10:9) If need to make this decision, raise your hand:

What to do next: Have them repeat after you: "I believe that Jesus is the son of God. I believe he died for me bearing my sins for me.I believe he rose from the dead and is alive right now. Dear Lord Jesus, come into my life now! Come into my heart now! I believe in my heart, and say with my mouth that Jesus Christ is my personal Lord as Savior. And I am, right now, born again."

2) Rededicate your life: \*Is your life a mess? \*Are you struggling right now? \*You know something is just off in life?{Read 1 John 1:9} If you want to be restored with God, raise your hand:

What to do next: Lead the person in the following prayer, allowing them to repent before God for the area they have sinned: "Father, I come before you in the Name of Jesus asking for forgiveness ... (allow the person to personally speak to God about the specific thing they are repenting for). After they are finished, close out the prayer with them, thanking God for forgiveness and restoration."
